HOUSTON, September 14, 2011 -- Excalibur Almaz USA (EA USA), a commercial aerospace company working to provide cargo and human transportation services, will showcase its space flown Reusable Return Vehicle (RRV) to area students on September 23 beginning at 8:30 a.m.

The RRV is one of the elements in EA USA's family of space systems that will serve as the transport vehicle to and from the EA Salyut-type space stations on orbit. With the recent retirement of the U.S. Space Shuttle, the EA USA RRV is the only existing reusable spacecraft which has flown multiple times.
