Mr. Diemoz has more than 30 years of aerospace industry experience in executive management, legal, export control and space operations working with NASA, Lockheed Martin and United Space Alliance, LLC (USA). He began his aerospace career with Lockheed Martin Space Operations (LMSOC) in 1982. At LMSOC he served as Company Counsel and negotiated the NASA Shuttle Processing Contract (SPC) at Kennedy Space Center (KSC) Florida.

In 1996, he was hired by United Space Alliance where he was responsible for the audit, export control, legal, security & technology protection functions of the Company. USA was NASA's prime contractor of its Space Flight Operations Contract (SFOC) which operated the Shuttle and International Space Station for NASA. Most recently he served as Vice President & General Counsel of United Space Alliance until his retirement in January of 2009. Throughout his career Diemoz has been closely associated with the NASA's Manned Space Flight programs and has worked closely with and for NASA astronauts and former astronauts.
